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#### **BEST TRADITION: ALL SAINTS DAY HOLIDAY, November 1**

Celebrated throughout Italy, Halloween coincides with the major Catholic holiday celebrating the dearly departed and saints. The day is dedicated to the saints of the Church who have attained heaven. All Saints' Day was formally started by Pope Boniface IV, who consecrated the Pantheon at Rome to the Virgin Mary and all the Martyrs on May 13 in 609 AD. Boniface IV also established All Souls' Day, which follows All Saints. The choice of the day may have been intended to co-opt the pagan holiday "Feast of the Lamures," a day which pagans used to placate the restless spirits of the dead, now celebrated as Halloween. Many will make a long weekend out of the holidays this year and you will find lots of Italians out enjoying the city and the Tuscan surrounds. The celebrating of Halloween itself has only recently been adopted here, and is mostly just for children. On November 1st some museums will be closed, and public transport works on a festive schedule. Many stores will be closed. Enjoy the festive mood in the streets or time with family!

#### BEST MARKET: MERCATO TEDESCO DI NATALE OPENS THE CHRISTMAS SEASON, November 18 - December 17

Hot mulled wine, great beer and a salty, smoky wurstel – all can be found in Piazza Santa Croce starting at the end of November, at the Mercato Tedesco di Natale (German Christmas Market). Traditional German food and craft products fill the square, there are also seventeen other countries represented in over fifty stands. A small Christmas village of charming wooden huts, with open areas of tables and chairs where you can sit and enjoy some of the rich German food on offer. Don't forget to try the apple strudel and the hot mulled wine! Open daily from 10am - 10pm.

## **BEST OF THE REST**

#### THE CHANGING OF THE GUARD, Nov 5

The Changing of the Guard in many European cities is one of the unmissable events for visitors from all over the world. It is a ritual that is renewed periodically and for some special occasions of great emotional impact. The history of Florence certainly takes us back to the years of the Siege of 1529/30, when Charles V wanted to bring the Medici family back to Florence by besieging the city. Florence had its own city army and Palazzo Vecchio or della Signoria, the city's seat of administration and power, was protected by a military group of the Army of the Florentine Republic: the Fanti di Palazzo, a group formed specifically to protect the 'Palazzo', the seat of power. The Army of the Florentine Republic was, however, composed of numerous other military groups with different intrinsic characteristics, which on occasion substituted the Fanti di Palazzo themselves in this very important task. #### THE JAPANESE FESTIVAL OF FLORENCE, Nov 26 and 27

On November 26th and 27th, 2024, the Fortezza da Basso will host the 25° edition of the Japanese Festival of Florence: an opportunity to immerse themselves in the rich Japanese tradition. The event will take place in the Arsenale Pavilion of the Fortress, where the public will attend performances of martial arts, including Bushido, Aikido, Karate, Kendo, and Judo, tea ceremonies, calligraphy and ikebana workshops, as well as traditional dance and music performances. # HELEN FRANKENTHALER, PAINTING WITHOUT RULES, EXHIBITION AT PALAZZO STROZZI, Until January 26

From: <u>The Florentine Magazine</u>. With her innovative soak-stain technique, the artist left her mark on the evolution of modern painting in a new relationship between colour, space and form. From September 27 to January 26, 2025, Palazzo Strozzi hosts Helen Frankenthaler. Painting Without Rules, a major exhibition celebrating one of the most important women artists of the 20th century, whose revolutionary research in painting is explored through works from her oeuvre between 1953 and 2002, in dialogue with paintings and sculptures by her contemporaries, including Jackson Pollock, Morris Louis, Robert Motherwell, Mark Rothko, David Smith and Anne Truitt. <u>Read more here</u>.

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#### DRIFT AT PALAZZO STROZZI, Until January

As part of the Palazzo Strozzi Future Art programme, in collaboration with the Hillary Merkus Recordati Foundation, Palazzo Strozzi presents a spectacular site-specific installation in the Renaissance courtyard, realised by the Dutch duo DRIFT. Renowned for installations, works and performance projects that combine art and technology, DRIFT offers a new perspective on the interaction between man, nature and space. <u>Website</u>.

#### **TEATRO DELLE RELAZIONI, INCLUDING A THREE DAY PERFORMANCE, Opens** November 7

In the recently renovated space of IED Firenze-Ex-teatro dell'Oriuolo, a new exhibition exploring the concept of community in its various forms will open on November 7, 2024. The project includes a three-day performance series at the Strozzina in Palazzo Strozzi, from November 28 to 30, designed to showcase a range of expressive languages. In addition to drawing and sculpture, the program will feature performance art, sound, and participatory practices. The works and performances examine shared cultural roots, artistic practice as a form of social transformation, and various forms of conviviality, addressing the collective need for spaces of connection and belonging. The exhibition will run from November 7 to December 20, with visiting hours from 9:00 AM to 6:00 PM, Monday through Friday, and entry is free. Website.

#### **OLTRECITTA': IMAGINING THE CITY, AT VILLA BARDINI, Until January 19**

From: <u>The Florentine Magazine</u>. Spread over two floors of Villa Bardini, 126 works by modern and contemporary artists offer thought-provoking answers. What is a city? That is the question at the heart of the latest collaboration between the Bardini Foundation and Lucia Fiaschi, curator of the show OltreCittà: Utopias and Reality along with Bruno Corà, Silvia Mantovani and Claudia Bucelli. Spread over two floors of <u>Villa Bardini</u>, 126 works by a myriad of modern and contemporary artists offer thought-provoking answers. Open until January 19, 2025 and featuring heavy hitters like Sol LeWitt, Boccioni, Burri, de Chirico, Le Corbusier and Pistoletto, the exhibit is divided into 12 themed sections presenting different creative perspectives on the built environment. In the treasure chest of the Cathedral of the Image that today you will come into contact with the art and life of Gustav Klimt, a revolutionary artist and creator of some of the most iconic pieces in the history of modern art. You will see him at the beginning and at the end of his career, passing through his greatest successes and glimpsing some moments of his private life. ## DANCE, THEATRE, AND MUSIC

#### PUCCINI DANCE CIRCUS OPERA AT TEATRO VERDI, Nov 30 and Dec 1

An absolute first: a show in which theatre, dance, live music, opera and contemporary circus intertwine on the stage, to create a new work on the occasion of the centenary of the death of Giacomo Puccini, one of the greatest musical composers of history. Puccini Dance Circus Opera – a choir of bodies and instruments – brings eleven women on stage (5 performers, a string trio, an electronic and cello musician directed by the director, an orchestra director), an orchestra of 45 musicians, to celebrate five female icons from the composer's works : Manon Lescaut, La Bohème, Tosca, Madame Butterfly and Turandot. It makes its debut on the ORT program in the Opera maior version in which the music, specially arranged by Francesco Oliveto, will be performed by the Orchestra della Toscana conducted by Gianna Fratta.
